

POSSUM CONTROL - USING BAIT-RITE® PASTE IN BAIT STATIONS

First registered in late 2014 , the following advice is provided by the manufacturer, Connovation Ltd:

- Bait-Rite Paste is an effective humane tool for multi-species control of feral pigs and possums.
- The active ingredient is encapsulated sodium nitrite and is very palatable to pigs and possums.
- Biodegradable with no persistent residues and no risk of secondary poisoning.
- Best results are achieved by prefeeding; this educates the target animals to bait placements and also ensures sufficient bait has been put out.
- As per our best practice the recommended prefeed to use before Bait-Rite Paste is our Ferafeed 213 Paste.
- For pig control use self-closing bait stations and for possums place bait into possum bait stations such as the Philproof Large or Mini.
- No licence is required to purchase and use.

Do not place within 10 m of a water body. Prevent access to the bait by domestic livestock and pigs. Stock must be kept out of the treatment area until baits have been removed or destroyed.

FIRST AID: If medical advice is needed, have product label at hand. For advice call the POISON CENTRE [0800 764 768] or a doctor.

IF SWALLOWED: Rinse mouth with water. Immediately get medical attention.

IF IN EYES: Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing. Get immediate medical attention.

IF ON SKIN (or hair): Immediately take off all contaminated clothing. Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention.

IF INHALED: If breathing is difficult, remove to fresh air and keep at rest in a position comfortable for breathing. Get immediate medical attention.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

Pre-feeding with non-toxic bait is required to maximise bait uptake. Do NOT mix non-toxic and toxic baits.

Feral pigs: Roll the Bait-Rite Paste into balls of 250g. Place these balls into a purpose designed bait station that will self-close after pigs have taken bait. Pre-feeding is recommended. Ensure gloves are worn during the mixing and dispensing process.

Possums: Roll the Bait-Rite Paste into balls of 20g. Place these balls into a bait station. Pre-feeding is recommended. Ensure gloves are worn during the mixing and dispensing process.

Legal obligations: By law this product must only be used as specified on the label. If the product is applied where public may have access to the treatment area, signs must be posted at normal points of entry to the area. Signs must remain in place for at least two months after the removal of bait and for four months after the last application of bait. The content and placement of signs must meet the requirements of the ACVM conditions of registration (see www.foodsafety.govt.nz) and HSN0 controls.

Users are required to be aware of all HSN0 controls for this product prior to use and to follow them, refer to www.epa.govt.nz.

STORAGE: Store in original container in a cool, well-ventilated place. Store at less than 30°C. Keep in secure place and away from children, foodstuffs, animals.

DISPOSAL: Dispose of unwanted or expired product by burying under at least 50cm of damp soil or in an approved managed landfill. Ensure bait is immediately covered to prevent scavenging. Do not use the empty container for anything else. Dispose by burying or burning.

SPILLAGE: Wear protective clothing and gloves. Search for and pick up any bait spilled around bait stations. Collect spillage and contaminated material into labelled container for disposal to approved landfill. **SUPPLIER:** Connovation Limited, 36 B Sir William Avenue, East Tamaki, Auckland
