warning: Toxic if swallowed. ZaP Possum Paste reacts with acids or water to produce the toxic gas, phosphine. Odour does not provide an adequate warning of dangerous phosphine concentrations. Inhalation of phosphine can cause severe toxic effects and may have delayed onset. Potential risk of secondary poisoning of others may occur from gas emitted from a person or animal who has consumed zinc phosphide. Suspected of damaging fertility or the unborn child. May cause damage to organs through prolonged or repeated exposure. Toxic to aquatic life.

PRECAUTIONS: ZaP Possum Paste is to be under the control of an Approved Handler and holder of a Controlled Substance Licence (CSL). Do not open where ventilation is insufficient. Avoid breathing any vapours. Keep ZaP Possum Paste dry until laid. Wash hands thoroughly after handling. Do not eat, drink or smoke when using this product. Prevent access to bait by non-target domestic animals, wildlife, and livestock.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: Must only be used in bait stations or bait bags.-*ZaP Possum Paste* is a single-feed poison. Pre-feeding before laying bait is strongly recommended. Remove all pre-feed when laying toxic bait.

When using reusable bait stations, lay in lines up to 150m apart and up to 150 m apart along these lines to cover the target area. Use bait take from prefeeding to determine how much toxic bait to place in each station.

Where pre-feeding is not practical allow approximately 300g of bait per station.

When using single use bait stations (e.g. Strikers W ZEALAND Defenders or bait bags) lay in lines at between 5m and 100 m intervals, depending on possum numbers. Sale 100 take from prefeeding can provide an indication of the size of the possum population.. Use approximately 20g of bait in bait bags or 18g of bait in strikers when these

have not been purchased prefilled.

Within 1 month of the final application of *ZaP Possum Paste*, recover and bury any untaken bait and disposable bait stations to a depth of at least 60 cm on site. Clean reusable bait stations of all residues before transporting off-site.

SYMPTOMS OF POISONING: Early symptoms are a garlic odour on the breath, abdominal pain, cough, headache and dizziness. This is followed by laboured breathing, nausea, vomiting and diarrhoea; then fatigue, ataxia, shallow breathing and unconsciousness.

FIRST AID: In the event of poisoning or suspected poisoning, act immediately. If person shows signs of symptoms, isolate from any source of contamination such as contaminated clothing or bait material. Rinse mouth. Call a doctor or take to nearest hospital without delay. Show this label or Safety Data Sheet. If contacted with skin or eyes wash with copious amounts of water. If you feel unwell or are concerned, get medical advice. For advice, contact National Poisons Centre 0800 POISON (0800 764 766).

STORAGE: Store in original packaging tightly closed until used. Do not expose to moisture or acids. Any product held after the expiry date shown on the container should be disposed of according to the disposal directions.

SPILLAGE: In the event of a spill, isolate the spill area and take all practical steps to mange any harmful effects. Scoop up spilled bait into secure labelled containers. Do not use water to clean up spilt baits. In the event of a major spill, refer to safety data sheet. Undamaged bait may be re-used if used straight way. Prevent spilt bait entering streams or waterways.

DISPOSAL: Dispose of unwanted or expired product either by burying under at least 60 cm of damp biologically active soil or transfer to an approved disposal facility. DO NOT use the empty container for any other purpose. Dispose of container by transfer to an approved disposal facility.
